


### How It Works


Students work their way through 10 Fry sight words at a time. You can begin on any list you'd like, or, start from the beginning. Coordinating assessment lists are included to make grading and assessing easy for the teacher, aide, or a parent volunteer. After a student successfully reads their word list, they color the matching space on their game board. After a student masters all ten sets (100 words), he collects a certificate and moves to the next set of 100 words. Focusing on just ten words at a time makes this program manageable for both students AND parents! Differentiating sight word instruction is easy and funl



### How to Differentiate Sight Word Identification

Students can practice their word list at home and/or school. They can also practice with my coordinating <u>Sight Word Spinner</u> pages, which you can find in my store <u>HERE</u>. Once a student has mastered the words, he or she moves onto the next list of words. Students will continue to work their way through the lists until all 500 words have been mastered! Students can keep track of what list they are on by using the *optional* student-friendly tracking sheets! You can even use this pack to keep track of spelling, too!




# Celebrate with Certificates!

Give your students a Sight Word Certificate when they master each of the IOO sight word lists. Print the certificates on colored cardstock for a printer-friendly version, or print the colored copies. Your students will love celebrating their success and collecting up to 5 different certificates!



## Organization Tip

Use a milk crate and file folders to organize the sight word lists and your assessments. Make class sets of the sight word lists and assessments. Place class copies of the word lists in file folders. Label the tops of the file folders so students can easily and quickly grab what they need when they move onto the next list of words. Some teachers choose to laminate copies of the word lists so that they can be used over and over again each year! ©



### Editable Templates
