



So Many Ways To "Write & Play!"


Each writing card can be used for informational AND opinion writing! Easy-to-follow posters and kid-friendly templates guide students through each piece of writing.

Various Ways To Use This Pack:

- -Place all 32 writing cards on a binder ring. Make multiple copies for an instant, choice-filled writing center! Students grab a writing ring, choose their topic, and get started! Make copies of the writing template that works best for your class or group of students.
- -Split the 32 writing cards up into categories for a variety of different writing rings! Swap the writing rings in and out of your writing center for weeks of writing fun!
- -Place the 10 "Fill It In" writing pieces in sheet protectors for an instant writing AND handwriting center!
- -Put the writing cards in a bucket. Students pull out a card and write about the topic!
- -Focus on one writing type at a time. Students use writing rings for informational writing. Later in the year, place them in your writing center again and focus on opinion pieces!











